Th	he council, pursuant to the Tile Drainage Act, enacts as follows:					
1.	. The Corporation of the City of Ottawa may, subject	t to				
	the provisions of this by-law, borrow on the credit of the Corporation such sums not exceeding in the whole \$2,500,000.	00				
	as determined by the council, and may issue debentures of the Corporation for the amount borrowed as provided in the Act					
	ayable to the Minister of Finance, which debentures shall reserve the right to prepay the whole or any part of principal and					
	interest owing at the time of such prepayment.					
2.	Where an application for a loan under the Act is approved by the council and the inspector of drainage has filed with the clerk					
an Inspection and Completion Certificate, the council may include a sum, not exceeding the amount applied for						
	five percent of the total cost of the drainage works with respect to which the loan is made, in a debenture payable to the					
	Minister of Finance in accordance with the Act, and may approve of the Corporation lending the said sum to the applicant.					
3.	. A special annual rate shall be imposed, levied and collected over and above all other rates upon the land in respect of whic	ch				
	the money is borrowed, sufficient for the payment of the principal and interest as provided by the Act.
