**REPORT RECOMMENDATION**

**That the Ottawa Public Library Board receive the 2013 fourth quarter financial reports.**

**RECOMMANDATION DU RAPPORT**

**Que le conseil de la Bibliothèque publique d'Ottawa prenne connaissance des rapports financiers du 4<sup>e</sup> trimestre de 2013.**

**BACKGROUND**

As of year-end 2013, the Ottawa Public Library (OPL) is reporting a surplus of \$337,652. Revenues are under budget by a little less than \$63,000 with fine revenues continuing to track under budget and lower than in 2011. This revenue line continues to be impacted by the fine notification system and facility closures for renovations. Expenditures are under budget by \$400,000 with savings in compensation as a result of RFID implementation at three branches (Alta Vista, Emerald Plaza, and Nepean CentrepoinTE). Savings will be used to create the additional positions needed to open

the expanded Beaverbrook Branch in the summer of 2014. Other expenditure savings occurred as a result of the 2013 capital transfers to operating for non-TCAR projects under IT and Professional Services.

## DISCUSSION

### Financial Reports:

#### **1. Operating Financial Report for first quarter, ending December 31, 2013, Appendix A**

- a. At year end, total Revenues are under budget by 1.7% or \$62,857. Although Library Fines were significantly under budget, this was partially offset by additional revenue from provincial and federal funding and on-going donations.

- b. At year-end, total expenditures are under budget by 0.9% or \$400,509.

Compensation is under budget by \$174,000 as a result of savings from RFID implementation set aside for the expanded Beaverbrook Branch. Equipment Service & Maintenance is under budget by \$266,000. Administrative Services is under budget by \$245,000. These expenditure lines increased in 2013 as a result of the transfer from capital for non-TCAR budgets for IT and professional services. This is offset by IT equipment requirements found under fixed assets, which is over budget by \$164,000.

- c. At 2013-year end, the Library has a surplus of \$337,652, 0.9% under the approved budget. The total surplus will be transferred to the Library reserve fund following the Surplus/Deficit Report to Council in 2013.

#### **2. Report on External Funds Raised for First Quarter: Appendix B**

Total revenue raised and spent from external funds in 2013 is \$512,676.

#### **3. Report on Contract Expenditures (October 1 to December 31, 2013): Appendix C**

In accordance with the Acquisitions of Goods and Services Procedure, Appendix C contains a list of contracts valued at more than \$10,000 and less than \$150,000, awarded for the period of October 1, 2013 to December 31, 2013. The Board approves contracts in excess of \$150,000.

**4. Library Board operation report for the First Quarter: Appendix D**

At year-end, the Board's operating budget is 54.9% spent.

**5. Capital Financial Report for First Quarter, ending December 31, 2013, Appendix E**

Attached in Appendix E is the report on capital spending as of year-end 2013.

**6. Report on Ottawa Public Library Trust Funds as at December 31, 2013: Appendix F**

The City of Ottawa, on behalf of the Ottawa Public Library, holds 14 trust funds. These are funds raised in the community to be held in trust for specific projects and/or library facilities and materials. As well, the Library receives funds from the Community Foundation of Ottawa, which is an external agency that manages a series of community trust funds, some with specific instructions to direct funds to the support of the Ottawa Public Library. The 2013 trust fund activity is outlined in Appendix F. Newly added this year is the Library Board's Fundraising trust account, 840046 with a balance of \$14,604.
