Executive Limitations Policy A.15, Administrative Practices was approved by the Board December 5, 2002 and last revised April 12, 2010. It states:

1. The CEO shall ensure that the Library's administrative practices are consistent with those of the City of Ottawa, provided that such practices are appropriate for the Library's operations, enhance productivity or customer service, and conform with Library policies.

As the 'parent' organization, the City of Ottawa provides a well-established and supported administrative framework in which the Ottawa Public Library operates.

This includes library access to powerful management tools such as SAP which is used to monitor and track human resources and financial systems. Recent examples include access to processes and tools for:

- Attendance Management
- Organization and position management transactions including submission and monitoring of time and leave (ongoing)

It should be noted that within SAP, the Library is considered a separate organizational unit, distinct from City departments.

Prior to implementing any City administrative practice, OPL evaluates the specific practice to ensure that it meets OPL's business requirements, and if modifications to reflect the Library's separate governance structure are required.
