### **CONTEXT**



- ■Board inquiry at June 2018 Board Meeting
  - Request for analysis
  - Apply full cost recovery approach proposed for Background Check Fees to Paid Duty Program
  - Report to FAC
- ■Board decision at October 2018 Board Meeting
  - Full cost recovery approach approved for Background Checks

### PAID DUTY FULL COST RECOVERY ANALYSIS



- Current fee structure
  - Hourly overtime rate + 20% overhead rate
- Full cost recovery fee structure
  - Hourly overtime rate + 35% overhead rate
- Example: Constable rate
  - Increases from \$84.90 to \$95.50 or 12.5%
- Estimated additional cost recovery of \$0.8m

## PAID DUTY FULL COST RECOVERY ANALYSIS



2017 Fiscal Year	Amount
Direct Costs	\$5,240,000
Overhead Rate:	
Full Cost Recovery: 35%	\$1,834,000
Current Cost Recovery: 20%	\$1,048,000
Difference	\$786,000

### **RECOMMENDATION**



- Adopt full cost recovery approach for Paid Duty Program by increasing overhead cost recovery fee to 35%
- ■Implementation decision:
  - Jan 1 2019 implementation Requires a December 2018 Board Report
  - Apr 1 2019 implementation Approve new rates through Budget process starting with February 2019 Budget Tabling Document
