# **BACKGROUND**

In 2001, the Provincial Government enacted Ontario Regulation 3/99 under the *Police Services Act of Ontario (PSA)*. The regulation, named *Adequacy and Effectiveness of Police Services*, is intended to ensure police services boards and police services implement the mechanisms required to provide effective delivery of policing services to the community.

#### DISCUSSION

The Ottawa Police Service (OPS) has establish a system of controls required to ensure the effective delivery of policing services. The Planning, Performance and Analytics (PPA) Section administers the compliance and quality assurance activities such as Control Self Assessment, Risk Management, Policy Development, and Internal Audit. PPA provides the framework for establishing and maintaining corporate policies and procedures; monitoring compliance through risk assessments and internal audits; and, reporting annually on compliance matters to the Board.

# COMPLIANCE WITH MINISTRY STANDARDS

Internal audits, management reviews and risk assessments are used to provide assurance to the Board that the OPS is proactive in monitoring compliance with Ministry Standards. This includes providing assurance that internal controls are effective and operational procedures and practices align. Information presented herein summarizes compliance related activities for 2015.

# **EXTERNAL AUDITS**

There were no external audits undertaken by the OPS in 2015.

#### **INTERNAL AUDIT**

LE-020 Collection, Preservation, and Control of Evidence and Property

Ministry Standards, Board Policy and OPS Procedure requires the police service to conduct an audit of all property and evidence in its custody. The objective was to assess the monitoring controls and processes employed by the Property and Evidence Control Section to ensure safekeeping measures are sufficient, firearms are fully accounted, and to provide assurance of conformity to legislative and policy requirements.

Compliance Review of O. Reg. 354/04 Major Case Management

The Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services has communicated its plan to conduct a comprehensive inspection of the Major Case Management process. In order to be proactive and prepared for the inspection, OPS engaged in a compliance review.

# Time and Attendance Audit

A comprehensive audit engagement was conducted to assess the level of compliance to established policies and guidelines, and to evaluate the efficiency and effectiveness of controls and monitoring practices related to time and attendance.

#### **RISK MANAGEMENT**

Control Self-Assessment (CSA) is a risk management process that enables the organization to proactively assess compliance with Ministry Standards. The process supports the alignment of OPS policies, procedures, and operations with Standards.

Last year 16 Standards were assessed, including a review of over 350 guidelines. The assessment confirmed that the OPS operations are compliant with these Standards, and has identified opportunities to further enhance communication, training, supervision practices.

To capitalize on these opportunities, Directorates have established management action plans (MAP) and incorporated them into Directorate Operational Plans. Progress on the MAP will be monitored through the Risk Management Committee (RMC). The following is a list of the Standards that were assessed in 2015.

Pursuant to S. 3 (1) of Ontario Regulation 550/96 a report has been prepared and submitted to the Minister of Community Safety and Correctional Services setting out the number of major cases the service investigated in 2015.

# SERVICE POLICIES (CHIEF'S PROCEDURES)

Service policies are a requirement of the Police Services Act (PSA), developed to direct members performing their duties when executing core services. The OPS Policy Management Framework provides the process to ensure service policies are compliant with current legislative and operational requirements. During the past year 10 service policies were revised and three were created. This included review by the Policy Development Committee, endorsement by Senior Management Committee and approval by the Chief of Police.

In 2016 an Audit of the Policy Management Framework has been included in the Audit Plan to support the continuous improvement of the OPS control environment.
