#### REPORT RECOMMENDATIONS

That the Ottawa Police Services Board approve the re-appointment of two (2) OPS members, listed in Document 1, as Special Constable pursuant to Section 53 of the *Police Services Act*, in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the attached Approval of Appointment form.

#### RECOMMANDATIONS DU RAPPORT

#### **BACKGROUND**

These employees are Special Constables assigned to the Central Cellblock and Prison Care unit. The re-appointment ensures that these employees can carry out their assigned duties as Special Constables. An application is made to the Ministry of

Community Safety and Correctional Services to have them re-appointed as Special Constable pursuant to Section 53 of the Police Services Act. The Ottawa Police Services Board appoints the employee(s) as Special Constable(s) upon approval by the Ministry for a five-year period or until the appointee is no longer in the employ of the Ottawa Police Service (OPS). Upon the termination of employment, the OPS advises the Ministry to terminate the appointment.

#### DISCUSSION

The Board is being asked to approve these re-appointments as Special Constables in accordance with the above noted process.

Some of their responsibilities include the transportation and custody of prisoners being moved between detention facilities and other locations such as courts; providing security at premises or places occupied or utilized as courts; maintaining security at the courthouse, cellblock, and other OPS detention facilities.

Approval has been obtained from the Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services for the re-appointment of these OPS members as Special Constables.
