For the information of Council, the following item was approved by the Finance and Economic Development Committee under Delegated Authority, at its meeting of July 6, 2021:

MOTION

Moved by Councillor A. Hubley

That the Rules of Procedure be suspended to consider the following Motion in order to ensure that staff proceed with the review in a timely manner.

WHEREAS The Official Plan calls for more intensification, particularly affordable housing as part of Transit Oriented Development near new transit stations on Stage 2 line. Queensview Station has considerable opportunities for conversion to a TOD;

WHEREAS The City currently owns an OC Transpo Bus Facility, which has a strategic location within 300 metres of the new Queensview O-Train station, and as publicly-owned land, it has the potential to be converted after Stage 2 is operational to provide public amenities in a rapidly-growing area;

WHEREAS the draft Parks and Recreation Facilities Plan states the need for more major recreation facilities such as a 50-metre indoor pool within the inner urban transect;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. Staff be directed to bring an information report to the Finance and Economic Development Committee to explain the process for considering relocation of the bus facility, taking into consideration that housing and recreational facilities may be a more appropriate use of the land after Stage 2 is in operation.
- 2. Staff be further directed in the same report to explain the process for developing a new plan for the adaptive re-use of the site, and how the local community can be engaged in a planning process.
