- Councilor Brockington had a pre-consultation meeting before the application got filed and got feedback from the community which was highly appreciated.
  Some concerns are still valid
  - Parking on 10th street is already near capacity and in the future could be impacted by redevelopment and infill.
  - requires a transition into the low-rise neighbourhood from the Westgate land, which is not provided in the secondary plan. The neighbourhood line in the secondary plan is directly behind the building.
  - vehicle side access regress is also a concern.
- This redevelopment combined with other developments in the area will bring Archibald street at or slightly over capacity as prescribed in the Secondary Plan phase 2 Transportation Impact study.
- hope this application will be approved sooner than later to deal with the construction impacts from all developments combined
