## Document 2 - By-Law to Authorize the Use of an Alternative Voting Method

## **BY-LAW NO. 2021-XX**

A by-law of the City of Ottawa to authorize the use of an alternative voting method for the Ward 4 (Kanata North) By-election.

WHEREAS Subsection 42(1)(b) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* provides that the Council of a local municipality may pass by-laws authorizing the use of an alternative voting method, such as voting by mail, that does not require electors to attend a voting place in order to vote; and

WHEREAS Subsection 42(5) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* provides that when a by-law authorizing the use of an alternative voting method is in effect, that Section 43 (advance vote) and Section 44 (voting proxies) shall only apply if the by-law so specifies; and

WHEREAS due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the City of Ottawa deems it in the interest of the City to pass a by-law to authorize electors to use an alternative voting method, being a Special Mail-in Ballot which may be returned by mail and does not require electors to attend a voting place in order to vote;

THEREFORE the Council of the City of Ottawa enacts as follows:

- 1. The Council hereby authorizes electors to use an alternative voting method for the Ward 4 (Kanata North) By-election, being a Special Mail-in Ballot established by the City Clerk which must be returned to the Elections Office or the Kanata Client Service Centre by 4:30 pm on January 24, 2022.
- 2. The City Clerk shall determine the dates, hours and locations during which the advance vote is held and shall establish the criteria for voting proxies to authorize proxy voting at a voting place but not proxy voting for the Special Mail-in Ballot.
