WHEREAS the City has no legal obligation to close roads for the development of subdivisions; and

WHEREAS these developments provide a significant financial return to the builder; and

WHEREAS these road closures cause stress, environmental damage, productivity loss and detour large volumes of traffic through neighbourhoods and past schools;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Planning Committee recommend to Council to approve the following:

- 1. Subject to Recommendation 2, the delegated authority of any staff pursuant to the Delegation of Authority By-law, or any other by-law or policy of the City, to close roads for more than 20 working days to support development be removed to ensure community concerns are heard and developers provide a safe detour to the satisfaction of the community, Ward Councillor(s) and Transportation Services;
- 2. Delegated Authority may be restored with the written concurrence of the Ward Councillor(s) in which the portions of the road proposed to be closed are located;
- 3. The General Manager, Planning, Infrastructure and Economic Development be directed to submit a report to Committee and Council in 2020 to provide recommendations as to an appropriate

process moving forward to ensure that the concerns expressed in this motion are addressed. CARRIED
