## **REPORT RECOMMENDATIONS**

**That the Standing Committee on Environmental Protection, Water and Waste Management recommend that Council:**

The Committee received a slide presentation overview of the report from Ms Charmaine Forgie, Manager, Business and Technical Support Services, Planning, Infrastructure and Economic Development (PIED) Department, and Ms Meagan Wheeler Cuddihy, Program Manager, Capital Planning and Strategic Asset Management, PIED. A copy of this presentation is held on file with the Office of the City Clerk.

Chair Moffatt spoke to provide context regarding the history of the City's Ditch Alteration Policy, and staff responded to members' questions, confirming that a memo would be provided to members of Council, outlining opportunities for greater public consultation on these ongoing policy matters.
