When the shots went off and our bouncer told us to drop to the ground I looked at the street and I saw multiple cops ready to react with guns drawn. Knowing they were there was the only thing that made us feel safe.

When I found out what had happened I have never been more proud to have you all protecting us. The cops didn't try to shoot and that may not mean much to you but to us it meant a lot.

Working in the market we are exposed to a lot but, gunshots right behind you is quite traumatizing. If more shots had gone off I don't know that we would have been able to stay calm, but that didn't happen. They controlled the situation properly and I am so grateful for that.

Following the incident, we had so much police presence that everyone felt comfortable getting out of their hiding spots and clearing the area. I witness the cops being beyond patient with intoxicated individuals trying to cross the crime scene.

To all the cops in the market:

Thank you for your overwhelming support. I try to thank you as much as possible but I want to tell you how appreciative we all are of your presence downtown. You make me and my coworkers feel comfortable walking to our cars/Ubers after work.

That may not mean much to you but coming from a group of women who used to all have to leave at the same time to ensure our safety it means a lot.

Thank you for the actions you took to keep us and our patrons safe on September 6. We were terrified and you remained calm to keep us safe.

We are so thankful and we want you to know how proud we are of you.
