Figure 1 Labour arbitration outcomes (Q1 to Q4 2021)




Figure 2 Civil litigation outcomes (Q1 to Q4 2021)




Figure 3 Ontario Land Tribunal (OLT) outcomes (Q1 to Q4 2021)





Figure 4 Other administrative outcomes (Q1 to Q4 2021)




Claims Unit

The Claims Unit received a total of 1,034 new claims in 2021. This figure represents the 797 property damage claims and 237 personal injury claims that were filed with the Unit. Of the total number of new claims received for 2021, 139 (13 per cent) represent pothole claims, which is annually the most common type of claim received by the Unit.

A summary of the 1,034 claims received during 2021 is set out below in Figure 5 by number.

The Claims Unit concluded a total of 1,082 claims in 2021. This figure represents the 778 property damage claims and 304 bodily injury claims that were either closed-settled or closed-denied during the year. A summary of the 374 claims that were closed-settled (i.e. paid in whole or in part) in 2021 is set out below in Figures 6 (by number) and 7 (by value).

Figure 6 Claims paid under \$100,000 by number (Q1 to Q4 2021)




Figure 7 Claims paid under \$100,000 by value (Q1 to Q4 2021)






Figure 9 Agreements/Documents registered - total
