REPORT RECOMMENDATION

That the Community and Protective Services Committee recommend that Council approve an extension of 12 months, from the date of approval, for the transfer of the plates of two plate holder licensees, under the Vehicle-for-Hire By-law, as further described in this report.

Councillor Qaqish was concerned that this has happened before and that staff may not react or document in a timely fashion. Anthony Di Monte, General Manager, Emergency and Protective Services stated that the department did not have delegated authority in the past and hopes that by reviewing the matter it will get rectified. Stuart Huxley, Senior Legal Counsel noted that measures were being taken to enhance the documentation and procedures.

The recommendations were CARRIED as presented.
