That, pursuant to Subsection 89(3) of Procedure By-law 2016-377, the Agriculture and Rural Affairs Committee approve the addition of this item for consideration by the Committee at today's meeting: Speed Reduction on Dunning Road

MOTION ARA 26/2

Moved by Councillor S. Blais

WHEREAS local residents have expressed concern about a high number of construction truck traffic using Dunning Road between Devine and Russell Roads, even though this section of Dunning is not a truck route; and

WHEREAS local residents have expressed concern about the high speed of construction truck and other types of traffic using Dunning Road between Devine and Russell Roads; and

WHEREAS local residents are requesting a reduction in speed on Dunning Road and the installation of Stop signs at the intersection of Dunning Road and Devine Roads as the best methods to improve safety on the roadway in front of their homes; and

WHEREAS homes on Dunning road between Devine Road and Russell Road are set close to Dunning Road and the current speed limit is 80km/h; and

WHEREAS the community is home to over two dozen young children, grandchildren, one daycare and one differently abled child in a motorized wheel chair and walking is part of daily activity; and

WHEREAS the speed limit is currently reduced to 50km/h on Dunning Road for a similarly configured stretch of homes just north of Russell Road for a short duration.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Agriculture and Rural Affairs Committee recommend that City Council approve of the reduction of speed on Dunning Road from 80km/h to 60km/h from just south of Devine road to Russell Road; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that installation a four-way stop control configuration be introduced at the corner of Dunning Road at Devine Road and complete any associated works required to establish the configuration at that intersection.

Councillor Blais spoke to the motion stating that many in the area had been asking for this and there was a petition in favour with 100% support by the local community.

The motion CARRIED as presented.
